





What Makes a Good School?



School Facilities

Lab Facility: St. Mary's English School has a well equipped composite lab for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics. We provide computer education in class-rooms and then in computer lab for practical.

Library: The school has made meticulous effort for providing a rich library with books on a variety of subjects for the extensive use of both teachers and students.







Music: The art of music and cultural activities are taught in the school by experienced musicians. Harmonium, keyboard, Guitar, Drum, Tabla etc. are taught among the students.

Taekwondo: The Korean martial art, Taekwondo is taught in the school by the expert. The students learn head-height kicks, jumping and spinning kicks, fast kicking techniques through out the year.

Smart Class: The institution ensures digital smart class rooms with multimedia support facility for the students of classes I to X, as we remain in touch with the modern innovations in educational system.

Physical Education: Adequate facilities with games and sports items are provided in the school. Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Cricket, Kabbadi, Kho-Kho, Handball and indoor games such as carrom, Ludo, chess etc. are encouraged and developed among the students.

Art Education: The school provides facilities for promoting art education among students. This is carried out through the experts who give theoretical and practical training for students, with the help of required facilities such as digital rooms, instruments and other equipments.

School Fees

Fee Rules

- 1. All fee are payable in advance upto 15th of the first month of each quarter. A late fee of ₹ 100 is applied after 15th
- 2. The mode of payment can be through online or offline.
- 3. Payment can be done with the help of Credit cards, Debit cards and Net Banking of any bank running in country.
- 4. Online payment can be carried out through the link, provided here; www.stmarysbarbigha.edu.in/fee-payment.php
- 5. Fees once paid will not be refunded in any case.
- 6. If a student is absent from school for a month or more, the name of such student will be struck off the rolls and the pupil may be re-admitted after have been paid.
- 7. No pupil will be allowed to appear for examination unless all fees and dues are paid up.

Code of Conduct [Every student must]

- 1. Wear the school uniform on all days as mentioned above
- 2. Keep cleanliness of dress and person.
- 3. Be fair and honest at work and consider the rights of others.
- 4. Be regular in attendance.
- 5. Be courteous and respectful towards parents teachers and visitors.
- 6. Look after and protect the property of school, keep it clean and tidy.
- 7. keep the classrooms neat and throw wastes papers/wrappers etc. in waste paper basket.
- 8. Consider the principal or the class teacher, if he/she demands any rectification.
- 9. Cling to the opportunity to enrich one's own talent and abilities.
- 10. Make home work as regular part of study.

Rules of the School

- 1. No students will be allowed to come to school without uniform.
- 2. Students will be punctual.
- 3. Participation of the student in the Assembly should be in an orderly manner.
- 4. Every student shall respect the Principal, Teachers and members of the administrative committee by greeting them.
- 5. School properties should not be damaged and it should be treated as their own.
- 6. Damaging school properties, writing or drawing on wall, door etc. and misusing school material and mis-behaviour must be avoided with utmost care.
- 7. No student shall disturb other classes on the flimsy-plea of getting the loan of a pencil, pen, book etc. from his / her friend.
- 8. Students from one class are not allowed to be in other class-rooms during intervals.
- 9. No one shall come to school without the Homework Diary.
- 10. No collection whatsoever by any student or teacher is allowed except with the written permission of the Principal.
- 11. It is not advisable to bring valuable materials to the school.
- 12. No student is allowed to go outside the school premises during the school hours.



- 13. A gentlemanly behavior is expected from every student. Each student must always remember that they will be judged by their conduct.
- 14. No boy or girl who has been absent from school without the leave renders will be admitted to class only after bringing a note explaining the reason for the absence which should carry the signature of the parents or guardian.
- 15. Students are not allowed to bring electronic gadgets like the mobile phones, Cameras, Cutting instruments into the school, If brought they will be confiscated.
- 16. It is strictly prohibited the use of burst crackers, or splash colours during Diwali/Holi or any other occasion in the school premises or in the school buses.

Points to remember

- 1. Never omit the lesson or homework assigned It is like missing a train that you never catch afterwards.
- 2. Never postpone what you can do today.
- 3. Live well by doing every thing well.
- 4. Obey the authorised people on duty.
- 5. Students behavior in and outside the school shall be exemplary. Any deviation can lead to consideration for suspension.

To the attention of parents

- 1. The absence of your ward from the School even for a single day is viewed with concern. He/She should not be encouraged to miss the School to attend some petty functions at home.
- 2. Should there be any infectious disease in your home, please report the fact to the principal at once and do not send your ward to school till the danger of infection has been overcome.
- 3. You are requested to send the tiffin and all the other materials required to carry out the days work with your ward or any other material and does not take the responsibility to deliver it to the children in the class.

School Terms & Vacation

The school opens at the first week of April and closes by the second week of May for summer vacation. The school session consists of two terms, the first term is from April to September & the second term extends from October to March.

Withdrawal

The intended withdrawal of a student from the school must be communicated to the principal in writing at least one calendar month (thirty days) in advance. The school reserves the right to ask the parents to withdraw their child if his/her progress in studies is unsatisfactory, attendance irregularity, harmful conduct, behavior of influence to be in any way determental to the interest of the school. Students who are absenting from the school without sufficient reason for more than a month will also be withdrawn. A Student who fails a second time in the school must be withdrawn from the school.


